WHEREAS, Section 61207 of the California Government Code specifies the amount of compensation that may be paid to Directors of Community Services Districts; and

WHEREAS, Directors and authorized District employees may from time to time when in the conduct of official District business expend personal funds for transportation and incidental expenses;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED THAT:

- l. Directors of the District will receive no compensation for either attending District meetings or for services rendered in the performance of their duties as Directors.
- 2. Directors and authorized District employees may be reimbursed for personal funds expended for transportation and incidental expenses incurred while performing authorized and official District business.
- 3. Reimbursement shall be based on the actual amount expended plus 20¢ per mile when use of a privately owned automobile is made for official District business.
- 4. Claims for reimbursement shall be included in the Agenda of a regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Directors and shall be approved by the Directors prior to reimbursement.
