**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE
VANDENBERG VILLAGE COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT
PROHIBITING REDUCTIONS IN THE SIZE OF WATER METERS
TO EXISTING CUSTOMER ACCOUNTS**

WHEREAS, meters are installed of a size and capacity to meet anticipated flow demands of the parcel to which water service is provided within the VVCSD system; and

WHEREAS, a certain portion of District revenues are tied to monthly service charges based on installed meter size to various parcels; and

WHEREAS, this Board finds a potential for adverse affects from allowing meter sizes to be reduced from the originally designed and installed size.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Vandenberg Village Community Services District that the policy of this District shall be to deny requests to reduce the size of existing water meters unless warranted by engineering study acceptable to the District General Manager.
