RESOLUTION NO. 12

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE VANDENBERG VILLAGE COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT LEVYING A SPECIAL TAX ON EACH DWELLING UNIT AND BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENT WITHIN THE DISTRICT AND SPECIFYING THE MANNER IN WHICH THIS SPECIAL TAX IS TO BE COLLECTED.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara, State of California, adopted Resolution No. 83-328 which authorized the Vandenberg Village Community Services District to levy a special tax in an amount up to \$25.00 per fiscal year for each dwelling unit and business establishment located within the District boundaries for a period of two years; and

WHEREAS, the authority to impose this special tax pursuant to said Resolution No. 83-328 shall not become operative unless and until the Vandenberg Village Community Services District is established, and said tax has been approved by a two-thirds vote of the voters within the territory of the District; and

WHEREAS, an election was held on November 8, 1983, and sufficient votes were cast in favor of the formation of the Vandenberg Village Community Services District, and subsequently said District was duly formed and established; and

WHEREAS, also on November 8, 1983, the voters within the territory of the Vandenberg Village Community Services District approved said special tax by an affirmative vote of more than the required two-thirds majority; and

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WHEREAS, the District has held and completed a Public Hearing on July 10, 1985, on the levying of said authorized special tax.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Vandenberg Village Community Services District that a special tax shall be levied in an amount not to exceed \$25.00 this fiscal year for each dwelling unit and each business establishment located within the District boundaries.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that this special tax shall be collected on the tax roll of Santa Barbara County in the same manner and at the same time as general ad valorem property taxes are collected. The specific amount levied and to be collected from the owner of each parcel is as shown on the attached copy of a Parcel Listing.
