

RESOLUTION NO. 16

A RESOLUTION OF THE VANDENBERG VILLAGE  
COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT TO PROVIDE  
FOR DISTRICT ELECTIONS TO BE CONSOLIDATED  
WITH STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTIONS ON EVEN  
NUMBERED YEARS

WHEREAS Assembly Bill No. 2737, approved by the Governor on June 24, 1986, filed with the Secretary of State on June 25, 1986, amended Section 36503.5 of the Government Code and Section 23302.1 of the Elections Code and,

WHEREAS Section 23302.1 added to the Election Code provides that a special district may, by resolution require that its election of governing body members be held on the same day as the statewide general election, and requires that the resolution setting the election shall provide dates that are consistent with the primary or general election with respect to nomination notices, canvass of votes, certification of election and all other procedural requirements of the Election Code pertaining to the primary or general election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The election for members of the Board of Directors of the Vandenberg Village Community Services District shall be held on the 1st Tuesday after the 1st Monday in November of even-numbered years and shall be consolidated with the statewide general elections. Members of the Board of Directors whose term of office would have, prior to the adoption of this resolution, expired prior to that election, shall instead, continue in their offices until their successors are elected and qualified, but in no event shall any term be extended more than 12 months.

2. (a). Nomination papers shall be filed with the Santa Barbara County Clerk beginning 113 days prior to the election and not later than 88 days prior to the election. If the incumbent does not file, nomination papers may be filed by non-incumbents not later than 83 days prior to the election.

(b). Notices of elections shall be advertised and posted at least 90 days and not more than 120 days before the day fixed for the general election.

(c). Canvass of votes shall be by the Board

of Elections on or before the 28th day after the general election.

(d). Certification of the Election by the Santa Barbara County Board of Supervisors shall be on or before the 28th day after the election.

(e). All procedures shall meet the requirements of the Elections Code pertaining to the primary or general election.

3. The Santa Barbara County Board of Supervisors is hereby requested to approve this resolution within 60 days of this submission in accordance with Section 23302.1 of the Elections Code and Section 25151 of the Government Code, so that this resolution will be operative in time for the November, 1988 election, and thus eliminating the November, 1987 election. On November 8, 1988 and thereafter Vandenberg Village Community Services District general elections will be held on the same date as the statewide general elections.
