

Vandenberg Village Community Services District (VVCS D)
Lompoc Unified School District (LUSD) Grant Application

The purpose of the VVCS D Water Conservation Program is to reduce water demand and promote efficient use of the groundwater supply so there is a sustainable water source for present and future residents. Under the program, grants may be awarded to LUSD for water conservation activities at Vandenberg Village Schools.

To apply, complete this application with required signatures and submit it to VVCS D by October 15. The Water/Wastewater Committee will review applications and forward recommendations to the Board of Directors, who will make the final decision by November 15 of each year.

The maximum grant amount is \$5,000. Funds will be dispersed directly to the school. VVCS D encourages applicants to seek matching funds but it is not a requirement. Teacher salaries and student labor are ineligible for grant funding and may not be counted toward the matching fund amount.

Please attach a separate narrative (no more than two pages) describing the project and addressing the following: What are the goals and objectives of the project? How will the project conserve or help conserve water? Estimated water savings per year? Who will be participating in and supporting the project? What is the minimum amount of grant funding needed to complete the project? What will happen if you do not receive the grant? Will the project, or part of the project, proceed without the grant?

Attach any information such as photos, sketches, cost estimates, calculations, or other details that further explain or support the application. Additional backup information may be required by VVCS D.

The undersigned have read and voluntarily sign this release and waiver of liability and indemnity agreement, and further agrees that no oral representations, statements or inducement apart from the foregoing written agreement have been made.
